

ARTISTIC APPROACH

My work explores the emotional territory of the body and its connection to matter. Through a sensory approach, I question the place of humans in the living world: their distancing from the natural world, their loss of contact with the elements, but also the deep desire for reconciliation.

I seek to re-inscribe humans into the landscape, not as spectators or exploiters, but as active participants. My perspective is that of a being out of step with modernity, but in search of reconnection with the earth, stone, soil, light, and breath. Each work becomes a space of resonance between my interiority and the life forms that surround me.

I ponder the similarities between humans and nature: their textures, rhythms, and capacity for transformation. This mimicry is at the heart of my creations, leading to a form of fusion between body and environment (Bois Blessé, ATARAKSIA, Fragments). My mediums are plural: video, photography, dance, gesture, and drawing. They dialogue with each other depending on the projects, serving a sensitive and intuitive writing.

Dance and gesture physically embody my reflections: movement becomes a language to express empathy with so-called mineral and vegetable resources, and the invisible inner emotional state of being. The camera (whether a reflex or a smartphone) captures these moments with equal attention. For me, the technical tool does not make the work; it is the gaze, the gesture, the intention that give it meaning.

Drawing, on the other hand, is a fundamental step in my practice. It allows me to think about space, anticipate forms, and feel even before filming or dancing. It is the first contact with the matter to come. I often think of my projects through sketches and storyboards. Drawing takes on a place of physical commitment in dematerialized works. It is also a primitive creative gesture, a call to rediscover one's instinct. For example, Like a Stone is inspired by the phenomenon of pareidolia to reveal human forms in stone and thus place us in a kind of indivisible relationship.

My work is part of a reflection inspired by the thought of Baptiste Morizot, particularly on the living as a subject in its own right. I question the way our societies exploit natural resources without consideration for the imbalance of their environment. Through poetic and plastic writing, I seek to give visibility to these materials, not as "resources" but as allies, beings, living matters. My project Ataraksia, for example, stages a carnal and intuitive relationship with rock: a gesture of contact, tenderness, almost ritual.

My creations take the form of short films (fiction, documentary, experimental), photographic series, and sometimes installations. Each time, I try to open a breach: a space where one can feel rather than understand; contemplate rather than name.



Development stage: writing the project, looking for production

Genre: Projet hybride, documentaire, post-photographique, art-vidéo et dessin traditionnel


Format: Video, Sound, and Plastic Installation, Short Film, +/- 15min

Theme: Greenland, the relationship to the landscape, glaciers, ecology, illusions, mirages, mining

Concept:

This is a virtual and sensory cartographic journey to Greenland, stitching together a fragmented memory from satellite image samples, audio interviews, and graphic materials.

This installation will be an invitation to contemplate the Greenlandic landscape through sound, through the sensitivity of local people to their territory, and through visual expression, through a process of "rematerialization" of a dematerialized work.

Development stage: exhibition concept

Genre: Photography, documentary, dreamlike

Theme: Chastreix, Sancy, resilience, ecology, fire, flora,

Concept:

It's easy to remain in Chaos, turning a blind eye to the difficult task of rebuilding slowly, with difficulty, but valiantly.

On April 7, 2025, the weather forecast predicted a winter drought, and a fire ravaged Chastreix in the Sancy region. The plains and bushes were reduced to ashes. This vision of Chaos evoked for me the image of bodies scraping the sky toward an exit.

On June 9, 2025, back in Chastreix, the spectacle was striking. Nature was returning to its former glory, flowers and insects teemed amidst the charred woods.



TERRATREM EARTHQUAKE

OU LE FRISSON DE LA TERRE

OR THE THRILL OF THE EARTH

Development stage: writing the script, looking for a production

Genre: fiction, comedy, drama


Format: Short film, +/- 15min

Theme: Mourning, initiatory path, dance, animal/human relationship

Pitch:

Arame, 28, walks with a group of tourists in the mountains to observe bears with a single goal: to draw bears in the wild. In this way, she fulfills the dream of her recently deceased mother, who passed on her passion for drawing to her.

Frustrated at only observing bears from afar, Arame decides to leave the group of tourists and follow her own path. Her solitary journey proves winding and trying. She is about to abandon her quest when one night, in the ruins of a village, she meets a woman who teaches her how to summon the bear with the ancestral rite of the bear dance. Arame continues on her way, contemplating nature through lines and dance. When bears finally appear, she is moved and finally stops drawing.



RÉ-INCARNATION RE-INCARNATION

Development stage: currently filming

Genre: documentary

Format: Short film,+/- 30min

Theme: Religious painting, spirituality, monastic life

Pitch:

In an Orthodox monastery nestled near Carcassonne, Sister Evangelique, a doctor and iconographer, perpetuates the ancestral art of tempera mural painting. This contemplative documentary follows her meticulous work in the heart of the cloister, while revealing, with modesty, the daily life of a community of women united by faith, silence, and creativity.

LES ARBRES AUX LONGS CHEVEUX THE TREES WITH LONG HAIR

Short film, performance film Length 19 min Full HD resolution


"Trees with Long Hair" is a performance film initiated by Gilivanka Kedzior, a performance artist from Occitanie. This project was born from a long-distance dialogue between France and Iran, between Gilivanka Kedzior and Farzaneh Soleimani Neisiani, curator of Hoorshid Artist House.

Prevented from attending an artist residency in Iran for diplomatic reasons, the artist Gilivanka Kedzior initiated, and enlisted my help, to create a video work anchored in another territory: the red dunes of Maraval, in the Tarn region.

Between introspection and creation, the film explores memory, roots, and inner exile, weaving a link between Iranian stories collected remotely and the forgotten landscapes of southern France. In this mythical and eroded setting, the artist's body becomes a vector of memory, in search of meaning and belonging.

Through a poetic and sensory capture, The Long Haired Trees reveals a theater of gestures, silences, colors, and tensions. It is not simply a performance piece: it is a visual work in its own right, a passage between two worlds, two geographies, two memories.

LIKE A STONE

A minimalist and poetic project in three steps: picking up a stone from a stairwell, tracing within it the lines of a body suggested by its natural forms, then placing it in its original location.

Without altering the material, the lines of the stone reveal the shapes of a body. Through the lines, I emphasize a presence, a face, a dance before returning the stone to its natural environment, the street.

Some already populate Colmar and Saint-Féréol.

BLUE STONE


BLUE STONE is a modular work composed of 15 urban stones, photographed with a smartphone and then digitally reworked. They question our dependence on mining technologies, even in our artistic gestures. The blue evokes both the sea and cyanide, in reference to marine mining.

The project plays on paradoxes: raw material, digital processing, falling or rising installations to restore the stone's nobility and provoke both critical and contemplative reflection.












FEU FIRE



Wild, disturbing the heat with an incendiary urgency.

The images are juxtaposed together in a kind of fire dance, an abstract visual trance that, depending on the densities, hues, and movements, draws the eye into waves of heat, sensuality, and swirling.

FIRE is an artistic gesture created with a cell phone, a work of blur, a play with randomness, and ghostly matter.

Composed of 45 modular photographs, variable dimensions

FRAGMENTS

At once smooth and rough, fragile and hard, the material reveals the strength and flaws that run through these portraits of women. Beyond chromatic abstraction and negative views, "Fragments" is a work of extraction of the sensitive, plunging into the depths and finesse of Human Beings.

JATTESTE TESTET

Two dancers on rooftops and hills seek each other despite the distance, listen to each other, and dance together. Our initially contemplative gaze gradually refocuses on the characters through a play on image ratios that evolves with the film.
